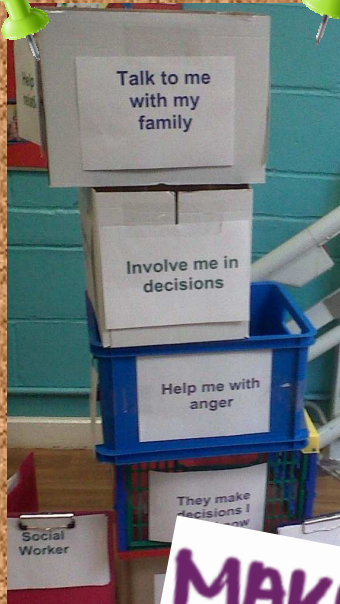
Our pledge 2014
