Qualification: This qualification aims to provide professional development opportunities for practitioners working in the Early Years Workforce. The learning requirements intend to increase knowledge and understanding through a combination of guided learning and personal research.

Course details: Ongoing assessor support will be provided using e-portfolio technology and the qualification will consist of workshops around the five units of the qualification, and one visit by the assessor to the setting. Learners must hold a full Level 3 Early Years or Childcare qualification and be employed in a setting. Learners can progress to the Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care and Children and Young People's Services or be prepared for further study of early years in higher education.
