

#### **CONDITIONS**

This form is valid for one year from the date you sign it, or for the period of time your child attends Foxgloves. The consent will automatically expire after this time.

We will not re-use any photographs or recordings after your child leaves Foxgloves.

We will not use the personal details or full names (first name and surname) of any child or adult in a photographic image on video, on our website, newsletter or in any of our other printed publications.

We may use a child's full name with an image for visual supports / schedules / labelling / on their file if appropriate and supports their level of understanding.

We will use the full name of a child to accompany a photo if it is evidence of achievement, remains on their file and is not published.

We will not include personal e-mail, postal addresses or telephone numbers on video, on our website, in our newsletter, on display or in other printed publications.

If we use photographs of individual children in an article we will not use the name of that child in the accompanying text or photo caption.

If we name a pupil in the text of a publication we will not use a photograph of that child to accompany the article.

We may use group photographs or footage with very general labels describing an activity e.g. 'Red nose Day' or 'trip to the seaside'.

We will only use images of children who are suitably dressed, to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.
