

# INFORMATION STATEMENT

## Stevington Parish Neighbourhood Planning Referendum

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday, 6 May 2021** to decide on the question below:
2. The question which will be asked in the referendum is;  
  
**‘Do you want Bedford Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Stevington to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?’**
3. The referendum area is **Stevington** as identified on the map
4. A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if on **Thursday, 6 May 2021**
  - He/She is entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area (the deadline for registration is Monday 19 April 2021)
  - His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A person’s qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the Register of Electors, the address in respect of which he or she entitled to be registered.
5. The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is **£2390.08** The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which the limit has been calculated is 476.
6. The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedure which are similar to those used at local government elections.
