About us

The Visual Impairment Team provides a specialist service for people of all ages and covers both Bedford Borough and Central Bedfordshire. The team is based in Bedford with one team member based in the Dunstable area.

Our aim

We aim to provide you with a prompt, easily accessible specialist service to support you practically and emotionally in understanding and coping with your sight loss.

We will work with you to:

- Maintain and increase your independence
- Increase choice and control in your daily life
- Enable you to access other support services
- Maintain and improve your quality of life

Services we provide

Following a specialist assessment of your needs we can provide:

- Individual rehabilitation training to enable you to manage daily tasks such as cooking, reading, shopping and getting about safely outdoors
- Guidance on appropriate benefits
- Advice and information on local and national services
- A direct payment to purchase appropriate specialist equipment

- Carers assessments (if you are caring for someone or someone is caring for you)
- Information and support for families and carers
- Signposting to other relevant services
- Visual awareness guidance
- Specific training for Deafblind people

Eligibility and access

We work with people who have impaired vision. If you experience sight loss which cannot be treated by medical intervention or glasses, you can request an assessment of your needs.

The assessment will be carried out by a specialist worker and determines whether you are eligible for services. It also helps us give priority as fairly as we can to those in greatest need of support.

There is no charge for the assessment. The worker will talk to you about any costs relating to the service(s) you need with you and will arrange for an assessment of your financial circumstances. We can also assess whether there are any benefits that you are entitled to receive.

Safeguarding Adults

Abuse is mistreatment by any other person that violates your human and civil rights. Bedford Borough Council is committed to safeguarding vulnerable adults from abuse (SOVA). If you are being abused or suspect that someone you know may be the victim of abuse contact Adults and Community Services on 01234 267422. Your concerns will be taken seriously and will receive prompt attention.
