### **POTHOLE FUND BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL GRANT DETERMINATION (2014/15): No 31/2391**

Bedford Borough council received grant funding of £511,618 in 2014/15 to carry out additional carriageway repairs on its highways network.
