Children Missing Education

How to make a referral as a professional



Children's Services, Schools and Families

Children missing education **or** at risk of missing education in Bedford.

“Our aim is to ensure that every child and young person has the opportunity to fulfil their potential and no child slips through the net.”

(DfES, Every Child Matters; Next Steps, 2004)

This leaflet is for members of all caring professions and agencies who have contact with children. It explains your responsibilities regarding any child that you have reason to believe may not be receiving the education that the law requires.

In Bedford we have produced a document “Children Missing Education Procedures” that should limit the risks.

Government Guidance states that all agencies who come into contact with children must co-operate with the Local Authority’s arrangements for identifying and reporting children who are believed to be missing or at risk of missing education.

Children missing education have a higher risk of:

- missing essential learning;
- suffering from mental health issues;
- being in danger of physical harm;
- being illegally employed;
- being exploited by unsuitable adults;
- becoming involved in criminal activity;
- demonstrating anti social behaviour;
- becoming easy prey for sex trade operators;
- abusing drugs and alcohol.

Parents and carers are legally responsible for their children and must ensure that they receive a full time education appropriate to their age and ability. Where parents or carers experience difficulty with doing this, the Local Authority may be able to offer help through its Education

Welfare Service and other services related to children.

We have appointed a Children Missing Education Officer who will:

- receive referrals from anyone who believes that a child may be missing education (including professionals, parents, children or members of the general public);
- link with all services as part of effective information-sharing and multi-agency practice;
- identify children who are not accessing education;
- track those children who are not identified as being on a school roll until they have accessed appropriate educational provision.
