Bedford Stations Travel Plan

Thank you for all the responses to the Bedford Stations Travel Plan survey. We received over 360 replies and this is a summary of what you told us...

65%



use the train to commute to work



50%



said that better or more direct bus services would improve their travel to the station

42%

travel less than 2 miles to get to the station



37%

walk to the station



58%

said that time taken was the most important factor when considering travel to the station

Over 60% of people who walk to the station live within 2 miles

Urban dwellers would prefer better cycle and walking facilities and routes, while rural dwellers would prefer more parking spaces





Recent developments...

- Woburn Road contraflow making cycling safer;
- Improvements to bus services in the town and rural areas including half hourly bus services to and from Bromham and later evening services to and from the station and town centre;
- Improved signage around St. Johns Station.

Look out for...

- Improvements to the former Focus DIY car park;
- More cycle parking at Bedford Midland station;
- Clearer walking routes to Bedford Midland station.
