



Notice of Making a Public Path Order  
Highways Act 1980

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (TURVEY: PART OF FOOTPATH No. A6)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

The above Order made on 22 June 2018 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert that length of Public Footpath number A6 Turvey commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number A6 Turvey to be retained approximately 140 metres north-west of Abbey Farm at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SP 9486/5196 shown as Point A on the order map then running in a generally south-easterly and south-south-easterly direction for 503 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number A6 Turvey to be retained approximately 378 metres south-south-east of Abbey Farm at OSGR SP 9504/5151 shown as Point B on the order map to a line commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number A6 Turvey to be retained approximately 140 metres north-west of Abbey Farm at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SP 9486/5196 shown as Point A on the order map then running in a generally south-south-westerly direction for 136 metres to a point at OSGR SP 9480/5184 shown as Point C on the order map then running in a generally south-easterly and south-south-easterly direction for 229 metres to a point at OSGR SP 9496/5170 shown as Point D on the order map then running in a generally southerly and south-easterly direction for 232 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number A6 Turvey to be retained approximately 378 metres south-south-east of Abbey Farm at OSGR SP 9504/5151 shown as Point B on the order map.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford from 10:00am to 4:00pm on Weekdays (Bank and Public Holidays excepted). Copies of the Order and Map may be bought there at the price of £5.00.

If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
