

Notice of Confirmation of Public Path Order
Highways Act 1980

Bedford Borough Council

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (RAVENS DEN: PARTS OF FOOTPATH No. 11 AND
THURLEIGH: PART OF FOOTPATH No. 10) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019**

On 4 November 2019 Bedford Borough Council confirmed as an unopposed order the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert:-

(i) A part of Public Footpath 10 Thurleigh commencing at a point where it joins that part of Footpath 10 Thurleigh to be retained approximately 48 metres north-north-west of the Parish Boundary between Thurleigh and Ravensden at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0607/5627 then running in a generally south-south-easterly direction for 48 metres to a point where it joins part of Public Footpath 11 Ravensden to be extinguished by this order at the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0608/5622 to a route commencing at a point where it joins that part of Footpath 10 Thurleigh to be retained approximately 48 metres north-north-east of the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0607/5627 then running in a generally south-south-easterly direction for 48 metres to a point where it joins a length of Public Footpath in Ravensden to be created by this order at the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0608/5622.

(ii) A part of Public Footpath 11 Ravensden commencing at a point where it joins that part of Public Footpath 10 Thurleigh to be extinguished by this order at the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0608/5622 then running in a generally southerly and east-south-easterly direction for 194 metres to a point where it joins that part of Footpath 11 to be extinguished by this order at OSGR TL 0621/5614 to a route commencing at a point where it joins a length of Public Footpath in Thurleigh to be created by this order at the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0608/5622 then running in a generally southerly and east-south-easterly direction for 185 metres to a point where it joins that part of Footpath Ravensden 11 to be retained and a length of Public Footpath in Ravensden to be created by this order at OSGR TL 0522/5614.

(iii) A part of Public Footpath 11 Ravensden commencing at a point where it joins that part of Footpath 11 to be retained at OSGR TL 0622/5614 then running in a generally southerly and south-south-easterly direction for 16 metres to a point where it joins that part of Footpath 11 to be retained at OSGR TL 0622/5613 to a route commencing at a point where it joins that part of Footpath 11 Ravensden to be retained and a length of Public Footpath in Ravensden to be created by this order at OSGR TL 0522/5614 then running in a generally east-south-easterly direction for 14 metres to a point where it joins that part of Footpath Ravensden 11 to be retained at OSGR TL 0622/5613.

(iv) Divert a contiguous route consisting of:

(a) A part of Public Footpath 11 Ravensden commencing at a point where it joins that part of Footpath 11 to be extinguished by this order at OSGR TL 0608/5620 then running in a generally westerly direction for 5 metres to a point where it joins that part of the Footpath described as Public Footpath 11 Ravensden but being located in Thurleigh to be extinguished by this order at the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0607/5620.

(b) A part of the Public Footpath described as Footpath 11 Ravensden but being located in Thurleigh commencing at a point where it joins that part of Footpath 11 Thurleigh to be

extinguished by this order at the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0607/5620 then running in a generally westerly direction for 30 metres to a point where it joins that part of Footpath 11 Ravensden to be extinguished by this order at the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0604/5620.

(ci) A part of Public Footpath 11 Ravensden commencing at a point where it joins that part of the Public Footpath described as Footpath 11 Ravensden but being located in Thurleigh to be extinguished by this order at the said Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 0604/5620 then running in a generally west-south-westerly direction for 190 metres to a point where it joins the eastern margin of publicly maintained road C22 "Ravensden Road: Thurleigh" at OSGR TL 0587/5612.

To a route commencing at a point where it joins a length of Public Footpath in Ravensden to be created by this order at OSGR TL 0608/5618 then running in a generally westerly direction for 42 metres to a point at OSGR TL 0599/5620 then running in a generally south-south-westerly and southerly direction for 160 metres to a point where it joins the eastern margin of publicly maintained road C22 "Ravensden Road: Thurleigh" at OSGR TL 0587/5612.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map (case reference HAD 055C) have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford from 10.00am to 4.00pm on weekdays (Public and Bank Holidays excepted). Copies of the order and map may be bought there at the price of £5.00.

The Order comes into force on the date on which Bedford Borough Council certify that the provisions of Article 1 of the Order have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 14 November 2019 make an application to the High Court.
