



Notice of Making a Public Path Order
Highways Act 1980 - Bedford Borough Council

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (RAVENS DEN: PARTS OF FOOTPATH Nos. 4 AND 29)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019**

The above Order made on 06 March 2019 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert:-

(i) A part of Public Footpath number 4 Ravensden commencing at a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number 4 to be retained to the north-east of the Ravensden Brook at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0639/5488 shown as Point A on the Order map then running in a generally north-easterly direction for 13 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number 29 Ravensden to be extinguished by this Order at OSGR TL 0640/5488 shown as Point B on the Order map then running in a generally south-easterly direction for 391 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number 4 to be retained at OSGR TL 0671/5466 shown as Point C on the Order map.

(ii) A part of Public Footpath number 29 Ravensden commencing at a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number 4 Ravensden to be extinguished by this Order at OSGR TL 0640/5488 shown as Point B on the Order map then running in a generally north-north-westerly direction for 148 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number 29 to be retained at OSGR TL 0633/5502 shown as Point D on the Order map.

To Lines:-

(i) Commencing at a point where it has a junction with that part of Public footpath number 4 Ravensden to be retained to the north-east of the Ravensden Brook at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0639/5488 shown as Point A on the Order map then running in a generally south-easterly direction for 395 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number 4 Ravensden to be retained at OSGR TL 0671/5466 shown as Point C on the Order map.

(ii) Commencing at a point where it has a junction with both that part of Public Footpath number 4 Ravensden to be retained and that length of Public footpath to be created by this Order described at (i) above to the north-east of the Ravensden Brook at OSGR TL 0639/5488 shown as Point A on the Order map then running in a generally north-north-westerly direction for 148 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number 29 Ravensden to be retained at OSGR TL 0633/5502 shown as Point D on the Order map.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford from 10.00am to 4.00pm on Weekdays (Bank and Public Holidays excepted). Copies of the Order and Map may be bought there at the price of £5.00.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn Bedford Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
