

Notice of Making a Public Path Order
Highways Act 1980

Bedford Borough Council

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (BRICKHILL: PART OF FOOTPATH No. 19 AND
PART OF BRIDLEWAY No. 23) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020**

The above Order made on 27 May 2020 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will:

(i) Divert that length of Public Footpath 19 in the Parish of Brickhill commencing from a point where it joins that part of Public Footpath 37 in Brickhill to be retained approximately 8 metres south-south-west of the western corner of the curtilage of the property 3, Thurne Way, Brickhill at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0570/5314 then running in a generally north-north-easterly and easterly direction for 56 metres to a point where it joins that part of Public Bridleway 23 in Brickhill to be extinguished by this Order approximately 5 metres north of the north-eastern corner of the curtilage of the said 3, Thurne Way, Brickhill at OSGR TL 0572/5318 to a route commencing from a point where it joins that part of Public Footpath 37 in Brickhill to be retained approximately 8 metres south-south-west of the western corner of the curtilage of 3, Thurne Way, Brickhill at OSGR TL 0570/5314 then running in a generally northerly and east-north-easterly direction for 65 metres to a point where it joins that part of the Public Bridleway to be created by this Order approximately 18 metres north of the north-eastern corner of the curtilage of 3, Thurne Way, Brickhill at OSGR TL 0573/5319.

(ii) Divert that length of Public Bridleway 23 in the Parish of Brickhill commencing from a point where it joins those parts of Public Bridleway 23 and Public Footpath 19 in Brickhill to be retained on the western side of the bridge at OSGR TL 0581/5323 then running in a generally south-westerly direction for 109 metres to a point where it joins that part of Public Footpath 19 in Brickhill to be extinguished by this Order approximately 5 metres north of the north-eastern corner of the curtilage of 3, Thurne Way, Brickhill at OSGR TL 0572/5318 then running in a generally south-westerly, north-westerly and westerly direction for 287 metres to a point where it joins that part of Public Bridleway 23 in Brickhill to be retained approximately 9 metres west of the western margin of public road "Ashmead Road" at OSGR TL 0549/5324 to a route commencing from a point where it joins those parts of Public Bridleway 23 and Public Footpath 19 in Brickhill to be retained on the western side of the bridge at OSGR TL 0581/5323 then running in a generally south-westerly direction for 100 metres to a point where it joins that part of the Public Footpath to be created by this Order approximately 18 metres north of the north-eastern corner of the curtilage of 3, Thurne Way, Brickhill at OSGR TL 0573/5319 then running in a generally north-north-westerly, west-south-westerly, west-north-westerly, south-south-westerly and westerly direction for 299 metres to a point where it joins that part of Public Bridleway 23 in Brickhill to be retained approximately 9 metres west of the western margin of public road "Ashmead Road" at OSGR TL 0549/5324.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn Bedford Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
