Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on 20th January 2017; extended on the 14th July 2017; extended on the 20th July 2018; extended on 19th July 2019; extended 17th July 2020 extended on 16th July 2021 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Wootton: Footpath No 1 which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0061 4441 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 0095 4362 (Map point B) has been further continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 23rd January 2023.

This closure is required to enable construction of a new housing development to take place. The closure will continue from Sunday 24th July 2022 for up to six months.

There is currently no alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation. The Order will come into operation on 24th July 2022 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
