BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

(HARROLD: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 4)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on the 1st December 2017, then extended to 9th December 2018 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along part of Footpath No 4 Harrold which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9480 5824 (Map point A) to OS GR SP 9508 5775 (Map point B) has been further continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 9th June 2019.

This closure is required due to the erosion of the bank along the path which requires revetment works and is expected to continue from 10th December 2018 for up to six months.

The alternate route for users while the closure is in place is to proceed from OS GR SP 9480 5824 (Map point A) in a southerly direction along Dungee Road to the junction with FP No 7 at OS GR SP 9524 5788 (Map point C), then proceed to its junction with FP No 4 at OS GR SP 9508 5775 (Map point B) and vice versa. The Order will continue in force until 9th June 2019 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
