(KNOTTING AND SOULDROP: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 2)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on the 16th March 2018 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along part of the length of Footpath No 2, Knotting and Souldrop which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9855 6153 (Map point A) to OS GR SP 9852 6117 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 25th March 2019.

This temporary closure is required to allow Network Rail to install a fourth track and associated equipment.

The closure will continue from Wednesday 26th September 2018 for a period of up to six months.

The alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation will be to proceed north westerly along Footpath No 42 for approx. 186m to its junction with Bridleway No 33 at OS GR SP 9810 6124. Continue north easterly over the bridge and continue along Back Lane for approx. 560m to its junction with Footpath No 32, then south east to junction with Footpath No 2 and vice versa.

The Order will continue in force until 25th March 2019 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
