( ROXTON: PART OF FOOTPATH NO A1)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on the 26<sup>th</sup> October 2018, and extended 18<sup>th</sup> April 2019 and 25<sup>th</sup> September 2020 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of part of public Footpath No A1, Roxton which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1601 5343 to OS GR TL 1599 5348, has been further continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021.

**The closure is required to replace the weir and lock footbridge. The closure will continue from Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2020 for a further period of one year.**

The alternative routes for users while the closure is in operation will be: Proceed from OS GR TL 1599 5348 southerly along Footpath No 5 Tempsford towards Church Street. Continue along Church Street to its junction with Mill Lane and onto Footpath No 8 Tempsford. Proceed southerly crossing footbridge to join Footpath No 7 Blunham. Continue along Footpath No 7 and at its junction with Grange Road turn left and proceed to the junction with Footpath No 4 Blunham. Proceed along the footpath until it reaches the weir and its junction with Footpath No 18 Great Barford. Continue to its junction with New Road and proceed north easterly to junction with Bridleway No 22 Great Barford. Continue along the Bridleway to its junction with Footpath No 19 Roxton. Proceed east along the Footpath to the weir and lock and vice versa.

The Order will continue in force until 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
