(CROSS END LANE (THURLEIGH: BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 49))

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person driving any mechanically propelled vehicle along Thurleigh BOAT No 49 known as Cross End Lane which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0630 5877 to OS GR TL 0628 6009.

This temporary closure is required due to poor surface conditions for vehicles. This follows an emergency closure made on the 30th October 2018 and is expected to continue from Wednesday 21st November 2018 for up to six months or until conditions improve.

There is no alternative route for vehicles while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 21st November 2018 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Byway have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
