(CROSS END LANE (THURLEIGH: BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 49))

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person driving any mechanically propelled vehicle along Thurleigh BOAT No 49 known as Cross End Lane which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0630 5877 to OS GR TL 0628 6009.

**This temporary closure is required to prevent damage to the surface of the lane. The condition is currently not suitable for vehicles. This follows an emergency closure made on the 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2020. The closure is expected to continue from Wednesday 13th January 2021.**

There is no alternative route for vehicles while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Byway have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
