(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on the 11<sup>th</sup> October 2019, then extended on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2020 and on the 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of part of Public Footpath No 4 Ravensden which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0615 5477 to (OS GR) TL 0639 5488 has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 17<sup>th</sup> April 2022.

**This closure is required due to the bridge being out of repair. The closure will continue from 18<sup>th</sup> April 2021 for a period of one year.**

The alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation will be to proceed from (OS GR) TL 0615 5477 east south east along Thurleigh Road (OS GR) TL 0661 5446 and then continue north easterly along Sunderland Hill to (OS GR) TL 0674 5464 proceed in a north westerly direction to OS GR TL 0639 5488 and vice versa.

The Order will continue in force until 17<sup>th</sup> April 2022 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
