(RAVENS DEN: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 4)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Part of Footpath No 4, Ravensden which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0615 5477 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 0639 5488 (Map point B).

This temporary closure is required due to the bridge being out of repair.

The closure will continue from Thursday 17th October 2019 for a period of six months. This follows an emergency made on the 25th September 2019.

The alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation will be to proceed from (OS GR) TL 0615 5477 (Map point A) east south east along Thurleigh Road (OS GR) TL 0661 5446 (Map point C) and then continue north easterly along Sunderland Hill to to (OS GR) TL 0674 5464 (Map point D) proceed in a north westerly direction to OS GR TL 0639 5488 (Map point B) and vice versa.

The Order will come into operation on 17th October 2019 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
