(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on the 30th October 2020 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Bolnhurst and Keysoe Public Footpath No 20, which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0855 5963 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 0772 5923 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 6th November 2021

This temporary closure is required until repairs to two bridges have been completed. The closure will continue from Thursday 6th May 2021 for up to six months.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in place.

The Order will come into operation on 6th May 2021 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
