GREAT DENHAM: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 32)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Kempston Urban Part of Footpath No 10 and Great Denham Part of Footpath No 32 which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference OS GR TL 0237 4765 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 0236 4767 (Map point B).

This closure is required following an inspection carried out on Kempston Mill bridge. The closure follows an emergency made on the 4th December 2020. The closure is expected to continue from Saturday 26th December 2020.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 26th December 2020 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
