

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)

(FORTY FOOT LANE SECTION 2 (KNOTTING AND SOULDROP: BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 10

AND WYMINGTON: BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 8))

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor bike to proceed along the length of public Byway No 10 Knotting and Souldrop and Byway No 8 Wymington which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9613 6117 to (OS GR) SP 9781 6254.

This temporary closure is required to protect the surface of the byway and follows an emergency made on the 29th December 2020. The closure will continue to take place from Tuesday 19th January 2021 and runs concurrently with the previous closure required due to holes caused by the badger setts.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 19th January 2021 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
