(PODINGTON: FOOTPATH NO 2)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of public Footpath No 2, Podington which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 9416 6281 9 (Map point A) to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 9419 6267 (Map Point B).

This temporary closure is required due to the bridge being washed away following an emergency made on the 8th February 2021. The closure is expected to continue from Tuesday 9th February 2021 to Sunday 8th August 2021.

The alternative routes for users while the closure is in operation will be: to proceed along the verge opposite (OS GR) TL 9416 6281 (Map point A) on Wymington Road in a south easterly direction and onto High Street in a south westerly direction to the junction with footpath No 2 at (OS GR) TL 9419 6267 (Map point B) and vice versa.

The Order will come into operation on 9th February 2021 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
