(SWINESHEAD: FOOTPATH NO A4)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of public Footpath No A4 Swineshead which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0598 65489 (Map point A) to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0644 2652 (Map Point B)

This temporary closure is required due to bridge being out of repair following an emergency made on the 21st January 2021. The closure is expected to take place from Thursday 11th February 2021 to Tuesday 10th August 2021.

The alternative routes for users while the closure is in operation will be to proceed south along Bolnhurst and Keysoe Footpath No 34 to (OS GR) TL 0626 6491 (Map point C) then in a westerly direction along Swineshead Bridleway No1 (OS GR)TL 0584 6503 (Map point D) then proceed along Pertenhall Road to its junction with Swineshead Footpath No A4 and vice versa.

The Order will come into operation on 11th February 2021 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
