(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle along the length of public Bridleway No 22 Ravensden and Bridleway No 9 Renhold which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0764 5258 (Map Point A) to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0696 5268 (Map Point B)

**This temporary closure is required due to a collapsed bank and follows an emergency notice made on the 10<sup>th</sup> February 2021. The closure will continue from Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2021 to Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2021**

There is no alternative routes for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2021 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
