(GREAT BARFORD: BRIDLEWAY NO 22 AND ROXTON: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 19)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle along the length of public Bridleway No 22 Great Barford and Part of Footpath No 19 Roxton which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1524 5351 (Map Point A) to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1359 5214 (Map Point B)

**This temporary closure is required due to the bridge being washed away in the recent floods and follows an emergency notice made on the 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021. The closure will continue from Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2021 to Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2021.**

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
