(COTTON END: FOOTPATH NO 6 AND CARDINGTON: FOOTPATH NO 4)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Cotton End: Footpath No 6 and Cardington: Footpath No 4 which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0862 4537 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 0967 4622 (Map point B)

This closure is required due to the bridge being out of repair. This closure follows an emergency made on 14th July 2022 and will continue from 5th August 2022 for up to six months.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 5th August 2022 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpaths have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
