Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on horseback along the length of Odell: Bridleway No 31 and Felmersham: Bridleway No 8 which extends from its junction with Mill Lane Odell at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9652 5775 to the OS GR SP 9711 5712 junction with Carlton Road Felmersham.

The closure follows an emergency made on 21st June 2022 and will continue from 12th July 2022 for up to six months.

There is no alternative route for horses while the closure is in place.

The Order will come into operation on 12th July 2022 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to bridleways have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
