

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON WIGRAM CLOSE AND HIGH STREET, ELSTOW

Reason for proposal: Bedford Borough Council has received a request from the Ward Councillor for Elstow and Stewartby Ward to consider installing parking restrictions at Wigram Close and High Street, Elstow. The proposals are aimed to improve access/egress and visibility at the road junctions.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce 'no waiting at anytime' (double yellow lines) restrictions on the following lengths of roads:

A	High Street
(i)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 15 metres in a southern direction from the centre of its junction with Wigram Close.
(ii)	On the east side of the road extending a distance of approximately 3 metres in a northern direction from the centre of its junction with Wigram Close.
(iii)	On the east side of the road from a point approximately 11.5 metres north of the centre of Wigram Close extending a distance of approximately 34 metres in a northern direction.
(iv)	On the west side of the road extending a distance of approximately 13 metres in a northern direction from the centre of Wigram Close.
B	Wigram Close
(i)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 13 metres in a western direction from the centre of its junction with High Street.
(ii)	On the southern side from a point approximately 28 metres west of the centre of High Street for a distance of approximately 10 metres in a westerly direction.
(iii)	On the eastern side extending a distance approximately 10 metres in a northern direction from the driveway serving the three garages at the back of property no.156 High Street.

2. As from the date upon which the Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (South of the River and Queens Park)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended" shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Reference J35 Revision 1" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Reference J35 Revision 2" shall be inserted
