

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN HARPUR WARD

Reason for proposal: Bedford Borough Council has received a request from the Ward Councillors for Harpur Ward to consider installing parking restrictions at various roads within their Ward. This is in response to complaints which they have received of inconsiderate parking. The proposals also include revoking parking restrictions in Turner Way.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce ‘no waiting at anytime’ (double yellow lines) restrictions on the following lengths of road:

A	Kneller Close
(i)	Upon its northern kerb extending from a point approximately 15.5 metres west of the junction of Turner Way in a north westerly direction then northerly direction for a length approximately 72m.
B	Rowlandson Way
(i)	Upon its eastern kerb extending from the junction of distance approximately 16.5 metres in a southern direction for a distance of approximately 35 metres.
C	Lely Close
(i)	Upon its northern kerb from the junction of Rowlandson Way in a north westerly direction for a distance approximately 21.5 metres.
D	Turner Way
(i)	Upon its eastern kerb extending from a point approximately 21 metres south of the junction of Gainsborough Rise for a distance of approximately 19 metres in a southerly direction.
E	Gainsborough Rise
(i)	On both sides of the road extending from a distance approximately 9.5 metres in an easterly direction from its junction with Turner Way for a distance of approximately 9.5 metres
(ii)	An extension of the existing yellow lines by a length approximately 1.5m in a northerly direction outside property no.50 Gainsborough Rise
F	Morland Way
(i)	On its northern kerb from a point approximately 12 metres east of its junction with Gainsborough Rise for a distance approximately 15 metres in an eastern direction
(ii)	On its southern kerb extending around the radius of the road junction fronting property no.5 Morland Way (an overall length approximately 22 metres)

2. To introduce ‘no waiting Monday – Friday 8am -9:30am and 3pm – 4:30pm’ (single yellow lines) restrictions on the following length of road:

A	Kneller Close
(i)	Upon its eastern kerb extending from a point approximately 87.5 metres north from the junction of Turner way for a length approximately 50 metres in a northern direction then approximately 25 metres in an eastern direction.
(ii)	From the driveway of no.14 Kneller Close in a north westerly direction on both sides of the turning head for a distance of approximately 13metres

3. To revoke the existing 'no waiting at anytime' restriction on the following length of road:

A	Turner Way
(i)	Upon its western kerb extending from a point 15 metres north from the centre of Kneller Close in a southerly direction for a distance approximately 31 metres
(ii)	Upon its western kerb extending from a point 15 metres north from the centre of Constable Hill in a southerly direction for a distance approximately 30 metres.

(ii)	“Grid Reference I23: Sheet Revision No 3” shall be deleted and “Grid Reference I23: Sheet Revision No 4” shall be substituted
(iii)	“Grid Reference J21: Sheet Revision No 1” shall be deleted and “Grid Reference J21: Sheet Revision No 2” shall be substituted
(iv)	“Grid Reference J22: Sheet Revision No 2” shall be deleted and “Grid Reference J22: Sheet Revision No 3” shall be substituted
