BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON HAWK DRIVE, BRICKHILL

Reason for proposal: Bedford Borough Council has received a request from the Ward Councillors for Brickhill Ward to consider installing additional parking restrictions outside the school to address inconsiderate parking.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce ‘no stopping, Mon-Fri, 8am – 4.30pm, on school entrance markings on the following road:

A	Hawk Drive
(i)	On its eastern side from a point approximately 87m north of the centre of Nightingale Avenue for a distance approximately 25 metres in a northern direction.
