Welcome to Sunflower House

Sunflower House is a specialist children's respite home, registered with Ofsted. It has five beds for short breaks for children aged between 7 and 18 years, We can offer longer stays if an assessed need is recognized.

Sunflower House is a purpose built bungalow in Putnoe, Bedford. Our staff team cater for a wide range of care, medical and dietary needs and are fully trained in all these areas.

The reasons you may need your child to come to Sunflower House are:

- To encourage independence;
- Give children the opportunity to experience time away from home in an equipped bungalow with friends;
- To give parents and carers a rest.

Visits by relatives and friends are more than welcome if you let us know when you are planning a visit.

Information about Sunflower House



All referrals to us are made via a social worker who will work with the family to carry out an assessment of need. The process to agree a package of care is via the Allocation Resource Panel (ARP). Initially families are invited to look around prior to making a decision about whether to use the service.

The Bungalow offers 5 bedrooms, which are all colourfully themed. We also have a lounge / dining room, kitchen, conservatory,

bathroom and toilet facilities, laundry room and large garden area. We have intercom systems in all the bedrooms to monitor the children at night as well as an emergency call system.

We also have our own wheelchair accessible mini bus which we use for outings.

We have specialist moving and handling equipment which can be used throughout the home.

Children's requests are included in decisions about where to go or what to do for leisure activities at the weekend or in the school holidays. Some of the leisure activities children and young people like to do whilst at Sunflower House include cinema, bowling, shopping, eating out, picnics, walks and visits to the beach and barge trips.

We also have a wide selection of books, games, crafts, CD's, toys, DVD's, Nintendo switch and Xbox 360 and games, and sensory toys.
