


Pan Bedfordshire Serious Incident Notification & Rapid Review Process

The Child Safeguarding Practice Review Panel will communicate their decision to the relevant Safeguarding Children Board within 15 working days of submission including any further information or clarification they require from the relevant Safeguarding Children Board.

If the case is a NHS Serious Incident, irrespective of whether the case proceeds to a Child Safeguarding Practice Review the CCG/ Health provider will share a copy of the 30 day and 60 day report with the relevant Case Review Group.

The aim of the notification/Rapid Review is to enable Safeguarding Partners to:

- Gather the facts about the case, as far as they can be readily established at the time
- Discuss whether there is any immediate action needed to ensure children's safety and share any learning appropriately
- Consider the potential for identifying improvements to safeguard and promote the welfare of children
- Decide what steps should be taken next, including whether or not to undertake a child safeguarding practice review.
